# SKETCH challenge

Layer the Hooray 3 template over any Polaroid template in the Hooray Template Set for extra personality and a perfect spot to showcase your title cards.



Add a personal touch to your banners and flowers by incorporating circles or punchouts. These simple additions bring a unique flair and extra dimension to your designs

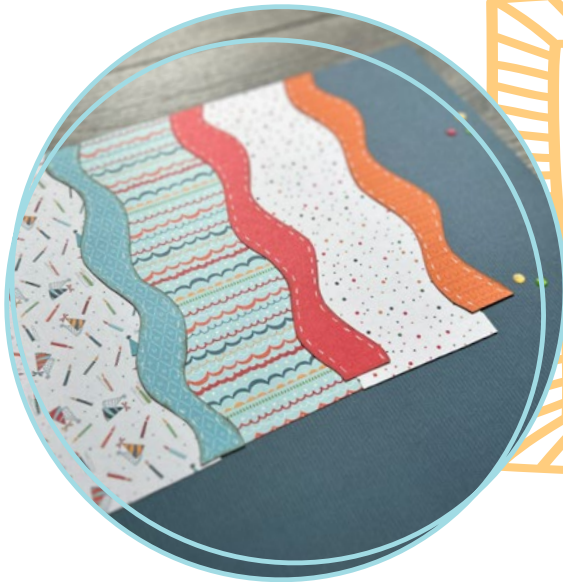

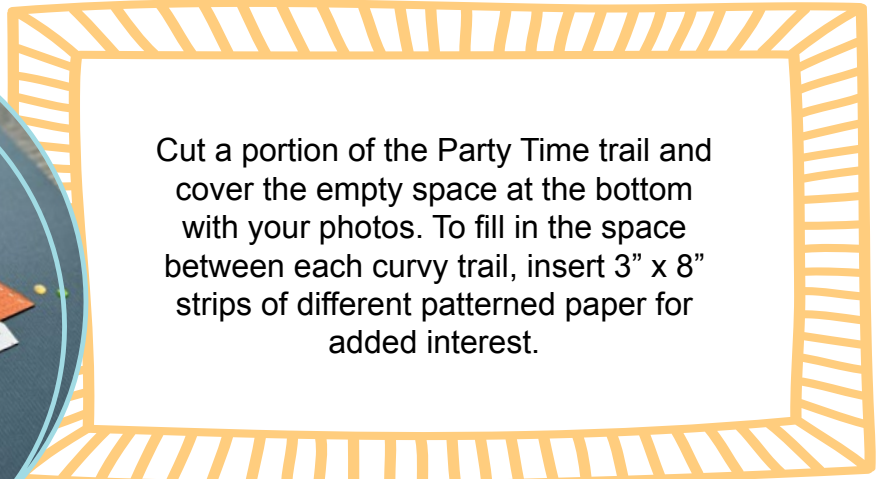

Enhance your Portrait designs and tabs effortlessly by incorporating the title card for added flair.





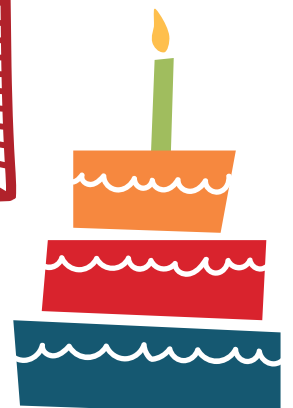
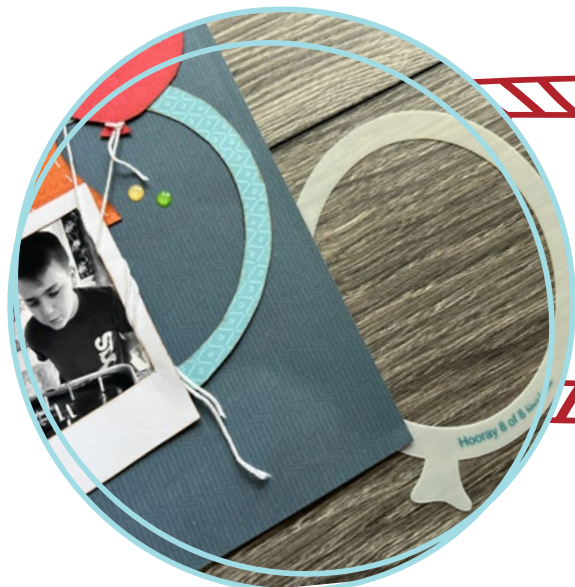
Cut a portion of the Party Time trail and cover the empty space at the bottom with your photos. To fill in the space between each curvy trail, insert 3" x 8" strips of different patterned paper for added interest.



Tie the end of your balloon strand around your photo frame for a more interactive and textured effect.



Use Hooray 8 as a small rings instead of a balloon for an added touch of color to your design

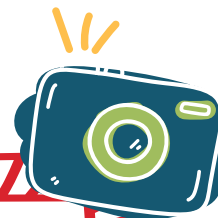

# WOOHOO

Use embroidery floss to bring your balloons to life and infuse your page with personality. It not only highlights specific elements but also adds delightful texture. To tie your balloons together, consider punching a hole through the slit of the Happy #3 template and thread the balloon string through for a charming, dimensional effect.





Layer vibrant paper of your choice over the top strip of your banner to make it truly stand out and achieve a dynamic, stringed-up effect. This contrast will not only make your banner pop off the page but also add a bold, eye-catching element to your design.

You don't always need large blocks of color to make an impact. Small, bold accents can make a significant difference. Enhance your polaroid pictures with details like enamel dots and layered paper to add extra charm and dimension.



Add ribbon to your gifts by cutting a thin strip of your chosen paper. Mary used red paper, cutting it into very thin strips and placing them over the Party Time 6 template. For the ribbon on the smaller Party Time 2 template, she cut the red paper into strips about an eighth to a quarter of an inch wide, forming small loops to resemble bows. Each piece of ribbon was applied separately, fanned out, and layered on top to create a dynamic, dimensional effect.



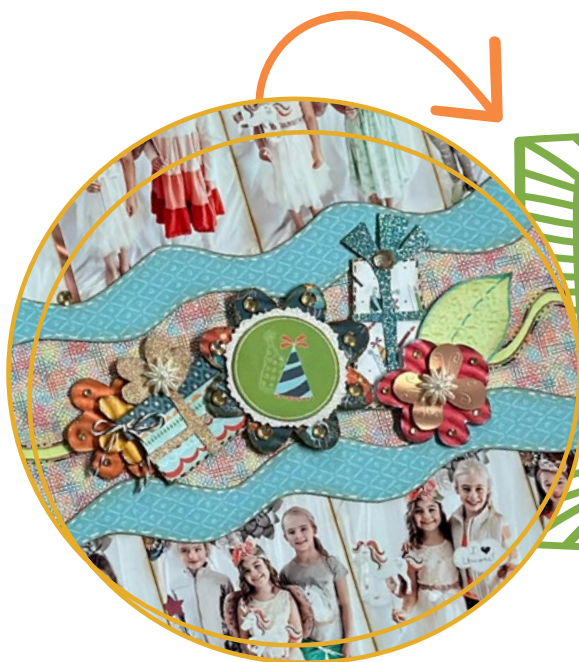

Layer the Party Time borders directly on top of each other for a unique look, adding movement and a groovy effect to your page.

Use different paper for each polaroid picture (Hooray 5, 6, 7), breaking up blocks of color and infusing your page with personality.



Try using the top part of the presents for the inside of the flowers, and for added texture, roll your floral arrangement through a crimper.

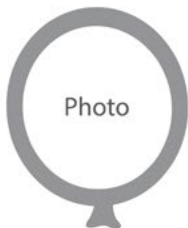
## Double the Fun: Layer and Play with Hooray #3 and YAY Templates!

These title cards are designed to work beautifully with both the Hooray #3 and YAY templates, allowing you to get creative with your scrapbook pages! For example, try placing the Hooray #3 template above "YAY" to create a cheerful phrase like "It's Your Day, Yay!" or layer it below for a playful twist: "Yay, It's Your Day." You can also mix and match with other titles listed below for even more personalized designs!



## Elevate Your Projects with the Versatile Balloon Template!

The stencil feature of your new Balloon Template allows for diverse designs on your next project. You can cut out the center and add a photo or paper of your choice, layer it with smaller templates in other sets, or simply cut it out and use it as a solid statement piece.



Use it as it is: A Balloon ring - OR-  
- Add a Photo Inside  
- Or a Title Inside

- Trace one as is  
- Trace inside to create a smaller one to layer together.

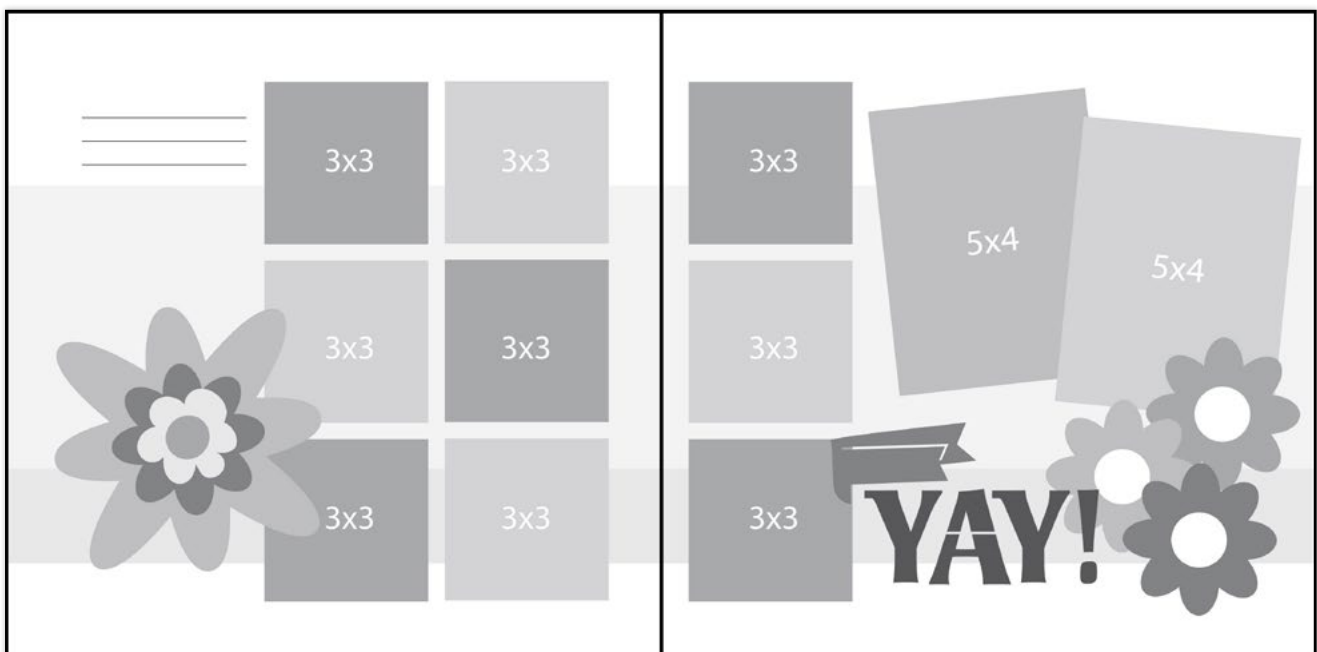
- Add a pattern inside of the balloon for added interest.

- Trace only the outside of the balloon for a solid effect.

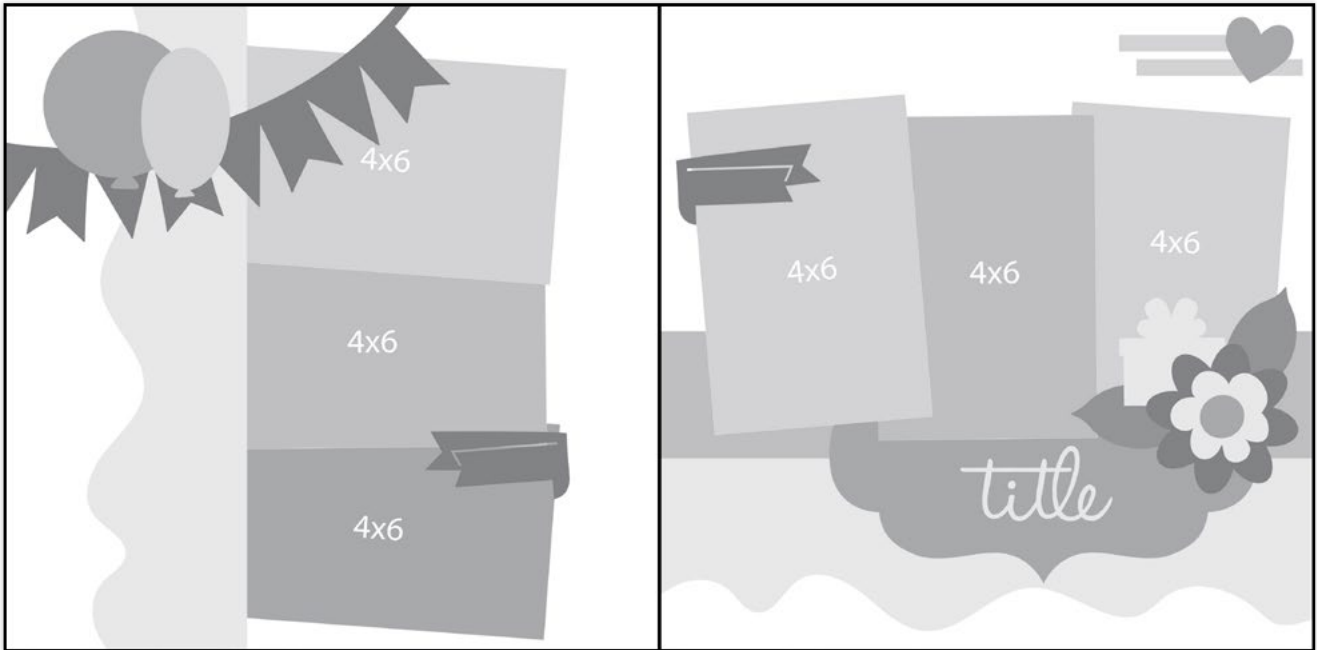
## GUIDELINES FOR CREATING YOUR OWN PAGES:

- Start by selecting the sample that sparks your inspiration.
- Take into account the number of photos you wish to include and your paper preferences.
- Gather the templates mentioned in the layout spread's recipe.
- Arrange the templates to craft a layout tailored to the number of photos you intend to include. (Don't forget to use the photo templates for this step – they're a fantastic time-saving tool and help streamline your creative process.)
- Trace, cut, ink, and replace each layer with your chosen paper or the papers shown in the sample.
- Celebrate your finished page!

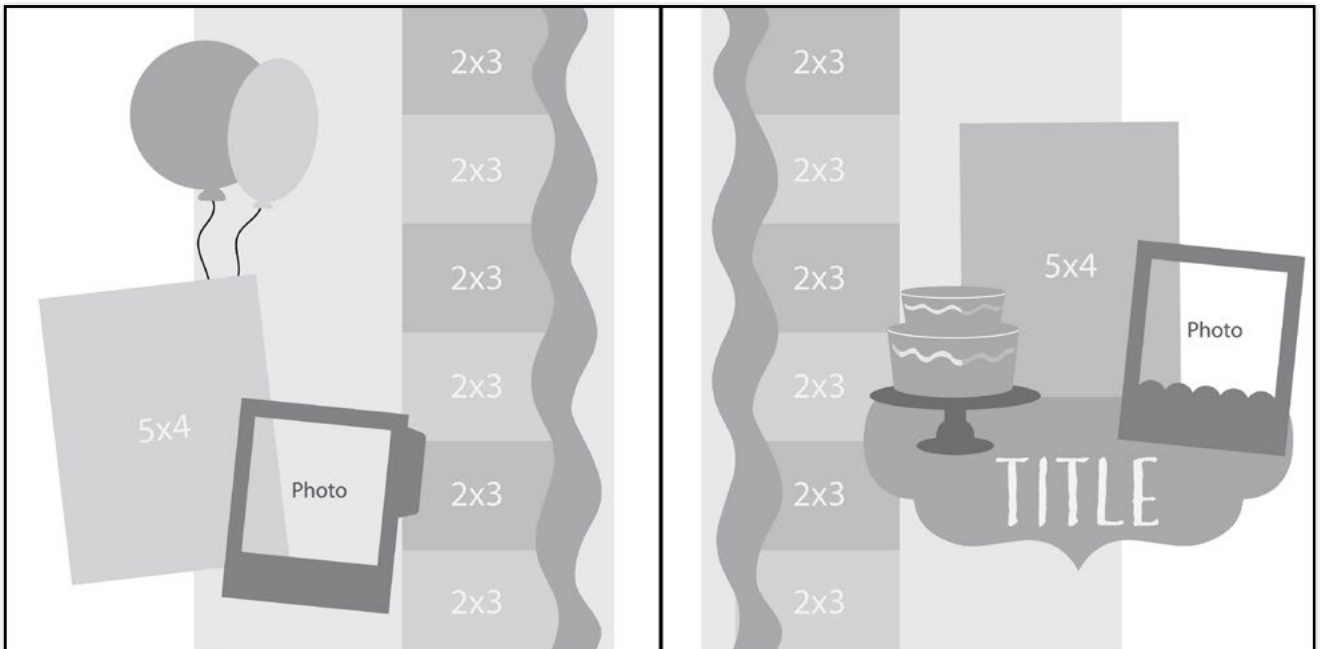

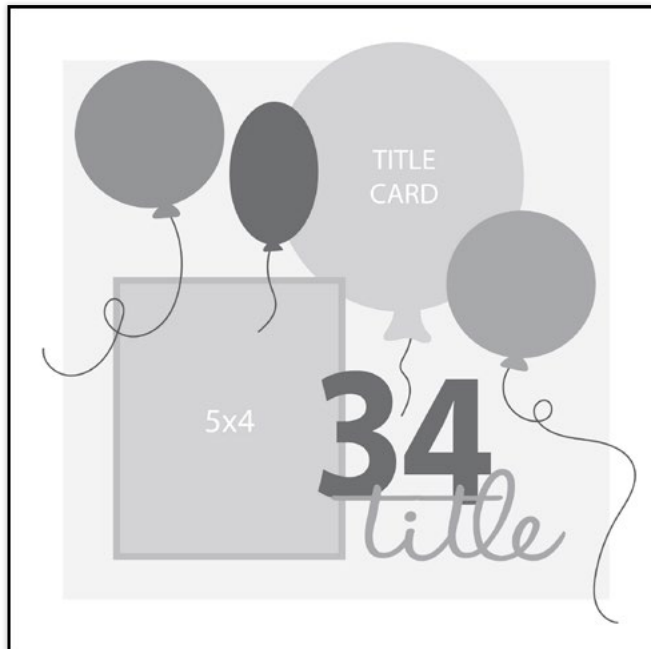
