Instead of using the full Rings template, trim off the end and align it with the straight edge of your paper. This technique creates a seamless look that blends beautifully into your layout—perfect if you want a more grounded design. It also makes a stunning canvas for your photos!

Enhance your embellishments with Diamond Dots and glitter pens to add shimmer, sparkle, and texture to butterflies, flowers, and other focal points on your page. Layer in rustic buttons, thread, or burlap for even more textured charm. Backdrops: Placemat 4, Streamers (2), Rings (4, 5, 6) Accessories: Tiny Plants (6, 9), Blossom (1, 5) Kiwi Club Sets: Lovely (2, 3, 4) Photos: Left: (1: 4 x 6), Right: (2: 5 x 4)

Cut out a rings template and use a 1/8" hole punch to make holes spaced ½ inch apart around the edges. Then, weave twine or thread of your choice in and out of the holes to add a fun, textured detail

Incorporate interactive journaling into your layout without taking up extra space by turning a photo into a pocket. Adhere only the outer edges of the photo to your page, leaving one side open to slide in a journaling card. Add a small tab to the card for easy pull-out access. For a creative touch, try using the upper portion of Placemats 4 as your journaling card.





Try creating vellum flowers for a soft, layered look. After cutting the shape from vellum, outline the edges with a thin marker and draw lines radiating from the center. Flip the piece over and lightly color in the lines with a soft-toned marker. Once flipped back, add tiny white dots with a gel pen for a whimsical finish. For a sparkly center, punch out small circles, add Stickles on top, and let them dry before adhering.

You don't always need to cut out paper to add a stylish touch with your templates. Try simply tracing the design directly onto your page using gel pens. This works especially well with backdrop templates like streamers, creating a minimalist canvas for your photos and accessories. You can also trace smaller embellishments, like tiny plants or leaves, to add subtle detail without added bulk.



Add a unique rustic touch by placing brads on each corner of your photos. This simple technique creates the look of a custom photo frame, helping each photo stand out with charm and texture.







Use the Lovely 4 template as a cutout to create a scalloped edge on your title cards instead of using it as a frame. This unexpected twist adds a soft, decorative border that brings a touch of charm and creativity to your page design.

Create a dimensional rose using the Blossom I template by first cutting it out of paper, then trimming a spiral into the flower shape. Roll and tuck the spiral inward to form a beautiful, layered rose. For a closer look at this technique, scan the QR code!



Enhance your butterfly designs by using a gel pen to add delicate details through the stencil feature of the template. This minimalist touch subtly elevates the design. For an extra pop, add enamel dots to the wings for added dimension and interest.





To create a variety of flower styles, try using the same template twice and offsetting it slightly to form a layered, multi-petal effect. You can also layer smaller flowers—like those from Tiny Plants—on top of larger ones such as Blossom to create a beautiful, decreasing-size petal look.

Use a paper piercer to curl flower petals for added dimension and shape. A ball stylus can also help loosen paper fibers and gently mold the petals, but a piercer offers more control for precise curling.






Create a subtle shadowed effect by layering the same journaling card shape—like Expressions 5—twice.

Simply cut the shape from two different papers or shades, then slightly offset the top layer over the bottom one. This easy technique adds depth, dimension, and a professional-looking finish to your journaling spots.



Use the Lovely 4 template to frame a photo and introduce creative variety to your layout. It's a great way to break up traditional photo blocks and add a unique, eye-catching element that draws attention to special moments.

Add playful dimension to your butterfly embellishments by layering two shapes with foam adhesive in between. For extra detail, place enamel dots in increasing (sizes within the stencil design of the top layer. This creates a sense of movement and gives the illusion of a shaker box effect—perfect for adding texture and visual interest to your layout.







#### **GUIDELINES FOR CREATING YOUR OWN PAGES:**

- Start by selecting the sample that sparks your inspiration.
- Take into account the number of photos you wish to include and your paper preferences.
- Gather the templates mentioned in the layout spread's recipe.
- Arrange the templates to craft a layout tailored to the number of photos you intend to include. (Don't forget to use the photo templates for this step they're a fantastic timesaving tool and help streamline your creative process.)
- Trace, cut, ink, and replace each layer with your chosen paper or the papers shown in the sample.
- Celebrate your finished page!


