4. POST a picture of your finished project in the 'Share YOUR ideas here' Group **by the 25th of the month before midnight MST.**



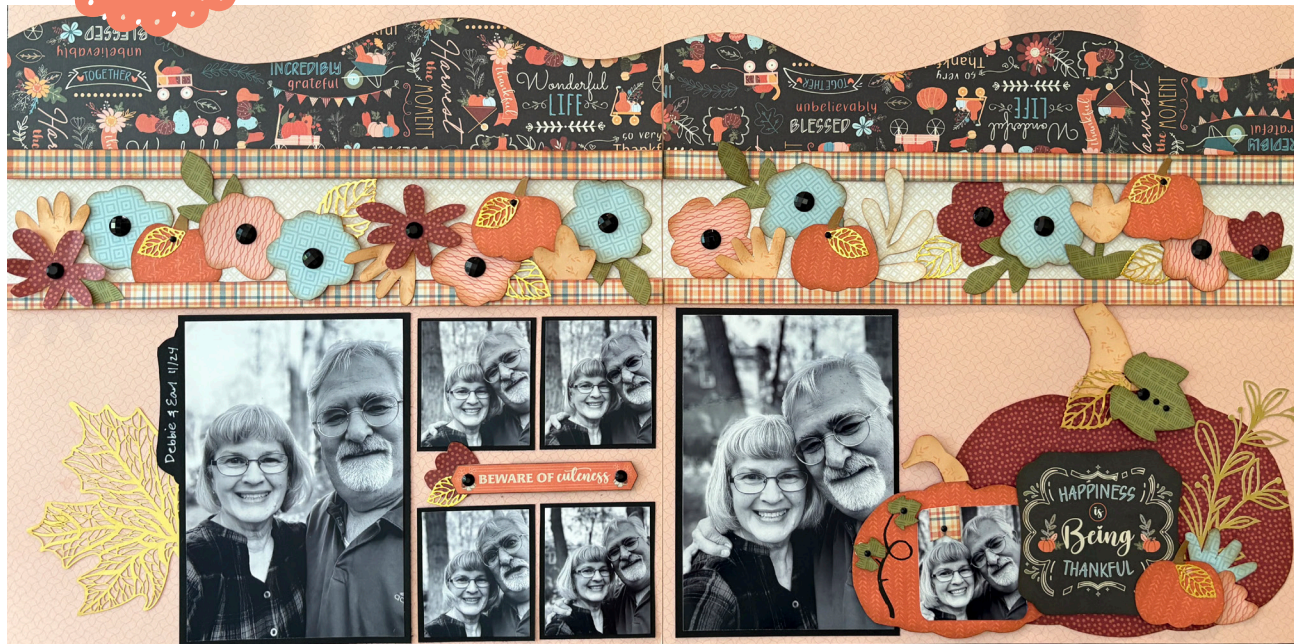

Borders: Abbie Road (3A, 3B)

Accessories: Tiny Plants (1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9), Tiny Seasons (5)

Kiwi Club Sets: Bountiful (4, 5, 8, 10, 12)

Photos: Left: (1: 4 x 6, 4: 2 x 2), Right (1: 4 x 6, 1: 3 x 3)

Create a one-of-a-kind border by building a strip of clustered flowers and leaves from Tiny Plants and pumpkins from Tiny Seasons. Add small touches like enamel dots or leaves, and you'll have a unique border that frames your page with charm and seasonal flair.



The inside of your pumpkin templates isn't just for photos, try using them for title cards or journaling, too. It's a simple way to make your pumpkins multi-purpose while tying your story into the design.



Get creative with how you place your photos! Tuck them in, line them up in a row, or create a photo block like Susan did, mixing sizes and leaving intentional gaps for title cards. When building a block of photos, try matting them or placing a block of paper behind for extra depth and definition, so they stand out beautifully from the page.

Accessories: Tiny Plants (4, 6), Creepy Crescents (5)

Kiwi Club Sets: Bountiful (4, 5, 8, 10, 12)

Create flip-up photo flaps to sneak in extra pictures or journaling without overcrowding your layout. It's a clever way to add more story while keeping the design tidy.



Slip a piece of vellum behind your ghost cutouts for a soft, phantom-like effect. The subtle layering gives your page a spooky but elegant touch.



Layer twine across paper strips for added texture and a cozy, rustic vibe. For extra charm, tie the twine through buttons and place them at the center of flower clusters, this creates a sense of balance and uniformity.



Not in the mood to cut or stitch? Grab your vine stencil and doodle instead! It's a simple way to add detail and movement while keeping things quick and playful.

Build up layers on your wagon to create a more realistic look and plenty of dimension. Layer and offset the wheels, doodle the edges of the handle, and add objects into the wagon to catch the eye and make it feel full and detailed.

Instead of tossing out small trimmings from your cuts, tuck them into your accessory clusters as extra filaments. They add a playful, 'wild sprig' look to your flowers, giving the whole cluster more life and texture.



The large pumpkin makes the perfect backdrop for a main photo. Break it into sections to create a 3D effect, then layer darker papers behind your leaves for subtle shadows. Add a touch of doodling to suggest movement, like the wind blowing tiny leaves, and you'll bring a sense of energy and playfulness to your page.

Cut zig-zag paper strips from the kit to create matching borders along both pages. This sets up a playful, textured frame that pulls the spread together.

Use Rings 4 & 5 as doodle guides, sketching lightly behind the Creepy Crescents backdrops for extra depth and whimsy.



Layer Cinema 6 with the Bountiful 12 pumpkin to create a fun pumpkin head centerpiece. Decorating the top with vines and leaves using Bountiful 10 and 12 stencils to add movement and seasonal flair.

Don't be afraid to stack and layer your border templates. This adds richness and flow, guiding the eye across your layout with ease.

Use the empty spaces inside your pumpkin templates to frame photos. It's a unique way to add personality, and if you stack them, you'll create height and movement across your page.



Seamlessly integrate your title cards into the wagon design. It not only ties the elements together but also turns your wagon into a storytelling centerpiece.





Short on space? Create flip-up spots to tuck in extra photos or journaling without cluttering your layout. Just make a simple hinge by cutting a paper strip (about 1/2" wide by 2-3" long), folding it in half, and adhering one side to the back of your photo and the other to your page. For multiple photos, offset your hinges, attach each new hinge to the back of the previous photo, and secure the bottom photo to your layout for stability. Add tabs, edging trim, or other little details to make the flips easy and fun to use.

Wrap twine around the tips of your pumpkins for a simple texture boost. It adds rustic charm and a tactile detail that makes your page feel handmade.

Don't be afraid to experiment with your pumpkins! Make them the focal point, turn them into journaling spots, use them as a foundation for your title, stack them for dimension, or simply tuck them behind photos for subtle layering and extra interest.

Add a little shimmer to your page for instant visual variety. Try glitter paper for letters, bats, or, like Jody, for the branch itself. You can also cluster sequins in the center of your flowers for extra sparkle, swapping them in for paper cutouts, enamel dots, or buttons.



Use the title cards in your kit to help tell the story of your page or to fill in tricky spaces. They don't have to be serious, sometimes a little sarcasm adds the perfect touch (because let's be honest, those cute cats couldn't scare a fly).

Stamp your title directly onto the background paper for a crisp, handcrafted touch. Stamping is a simple, no-fuss way to add a title without overthinking it, and depending on the ink you choose, it can bring a warm rustic feel that beautifully complements your layout.

Cut out your leaves, then lightly spritz them with water to soften the paper fibers. Crumple each one into a little ball for instant texture, then gently unfold and let them dry flat. Once dry, ink them in a coordinating color - the texture will pop beautifully!



Use the Creepy Crescent template to cut out jack-o'-lantern pumpkins, then layer them inside the Bountiful 7 Wagon template. The combination creates a fun, personality-filled cluster that instantly draws the eye.

Tuck your journaling into a library pocket hidden on the back of your layout. It's the perfect way to include heartfelt notes while keeping the front design clean and creative.

Use embroidery floss to sew delicate vines that weave around and across your pumpkins. For added charm, mix smaller leaf stencils with larger leaf templates along the vines for added variety and a natural, flowing look.

Don't let those pumpkin cutouts go to waste - use them as playful platforms for your page titles or layer them under photos and embellishments. The stencil feature makes it easy to create dimension and depth, giving your page a polished finish.



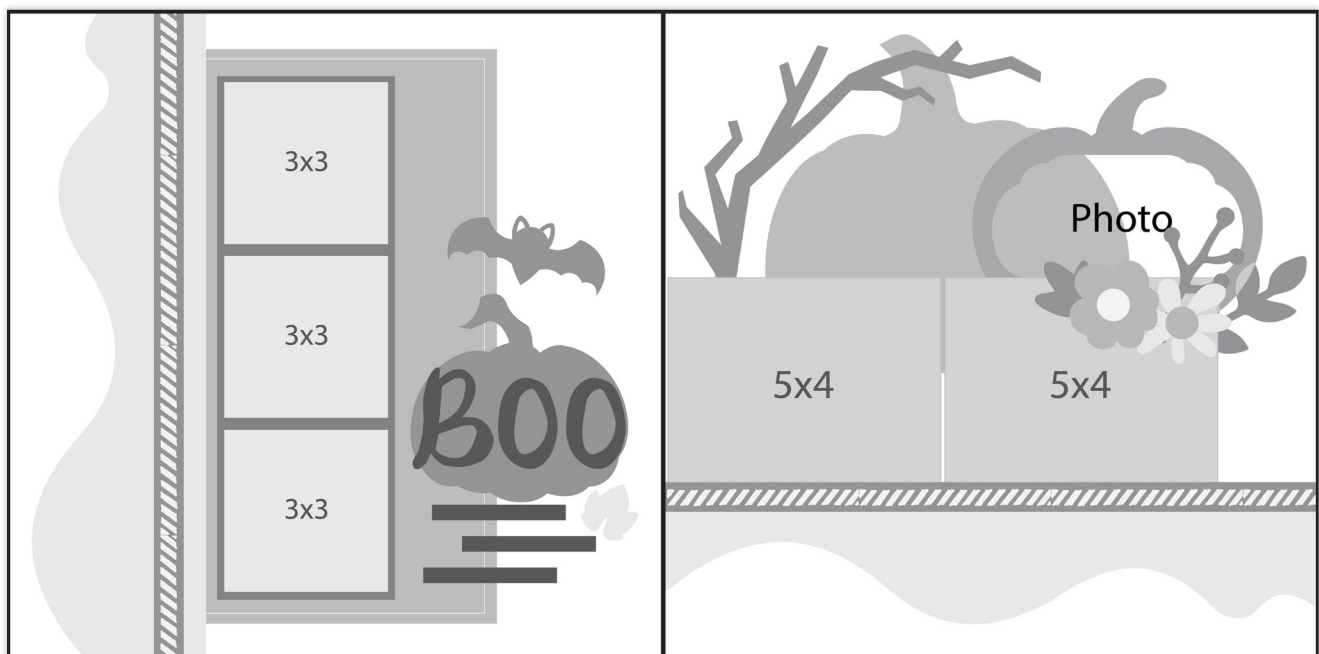

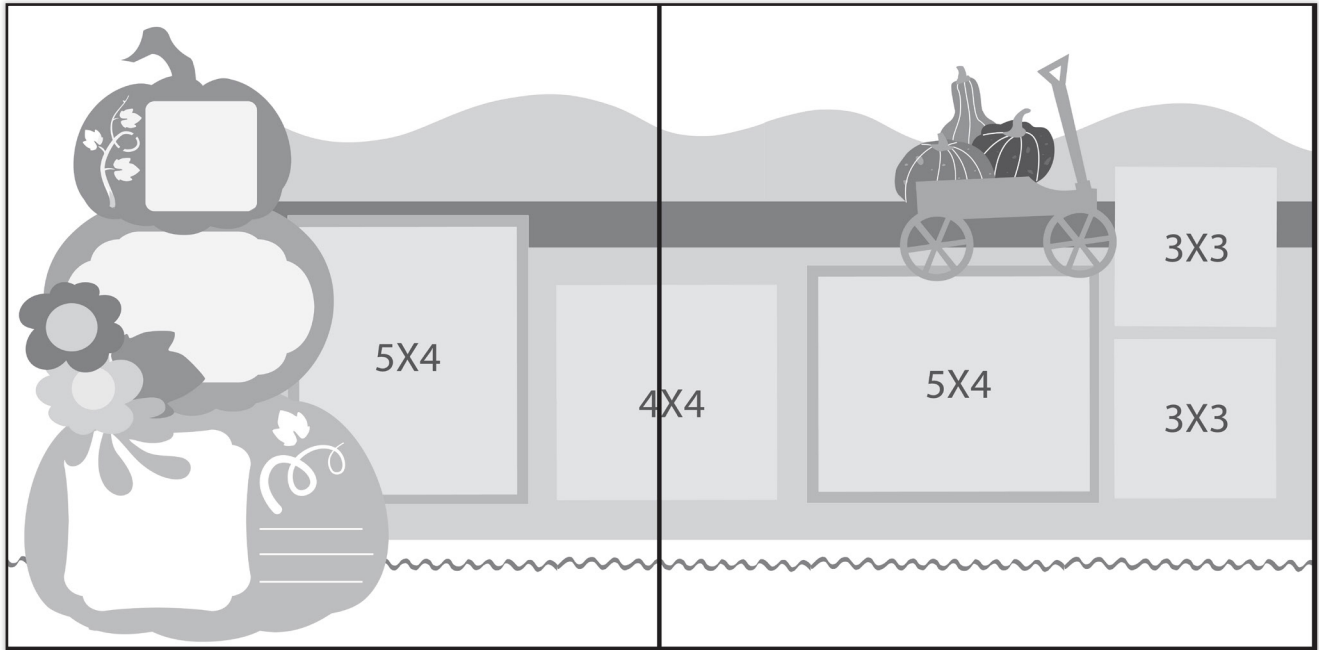
GUIDELINES FOR CREATING YOUR OWN PAGES:

- Start by selecting the sample that sparks your inspiration.
- Take into account the number of photos you wish to include and your paper preferences.
- Gather the templates mentioned in the layout spread's recipe.
- Arrange the templates to craft a layout tailored to the number of photos you intend to include. (Don't forget to use the photo templates for this step – they're a fantastic time-saving tool and help streamline your creative process.)
- Trace, cut, ink, and replace each layer with your chosen paper or the papers shown in the sample.
- Celebrate your finished page!

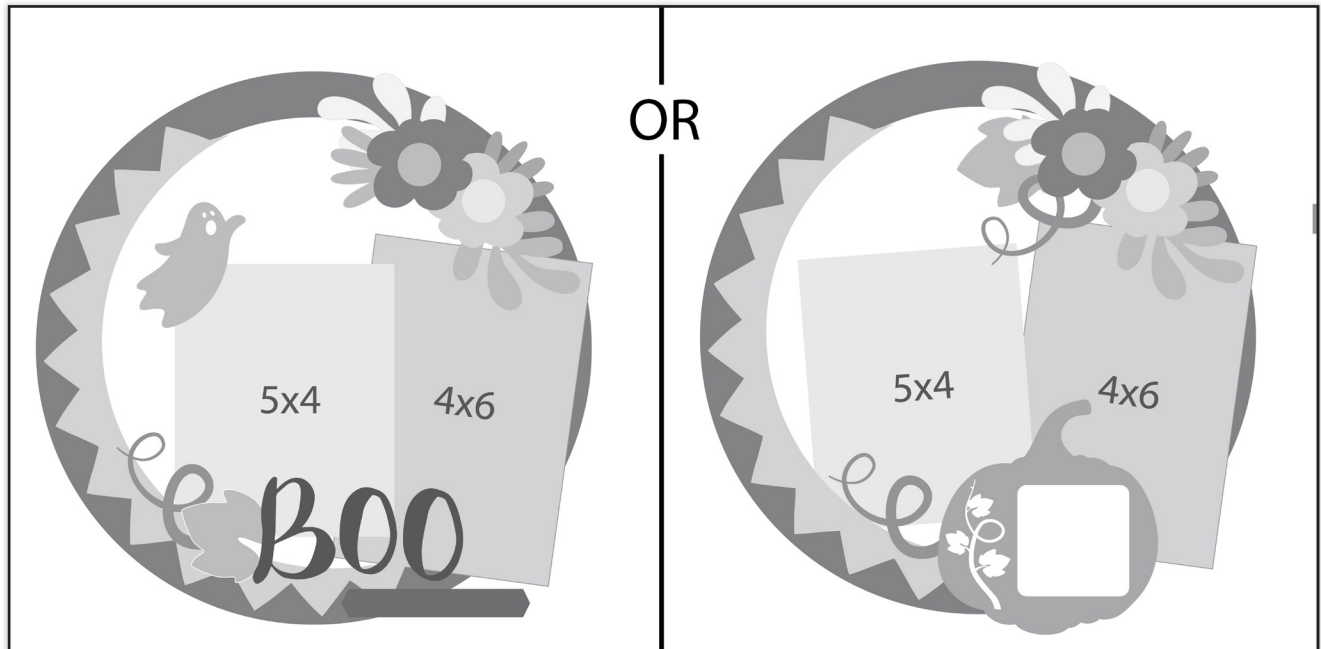
