- background papers that help anchor your page and allow the design to stand out (6 sheets)

This gives you a chance to experience the Kiwi Lane paper formula in action through practice—seeing how patterns, colors, and backgrounds support one another on a finished page.

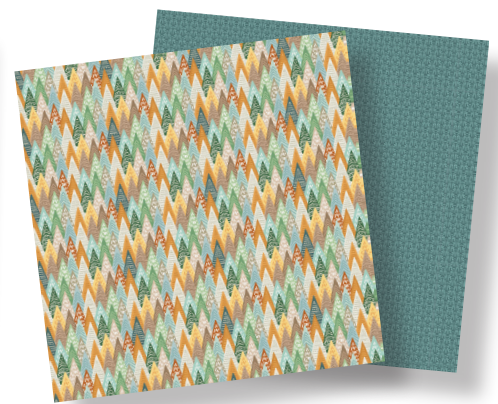
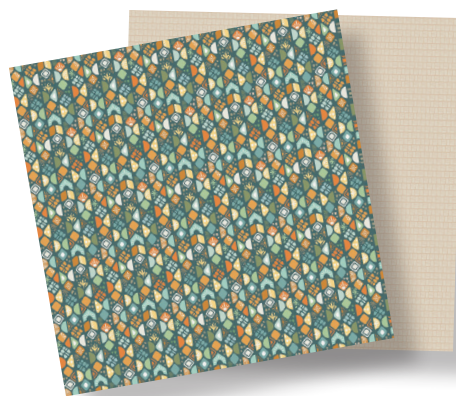
With the paper choices already working together, you don't have to worry about whether the patterns will match. You can simply create with confidence, **knowing your page will come together beautifully for the memories it holds.**

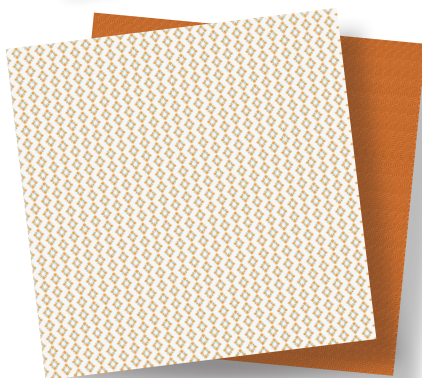

TITLE & STORY ANGLE

Start by looking through the titles and noticing which ones resonate with you—**often they will point to the memory your page is meant to hold.**

Sometimes a title card will immediately remind you of a moment you want to preserve. Other times it may help you see a slightly different angle of the story behind your photos or they can also act as simple story prompts.

The title cards included in this kit are designed to fit beautifully within the suggested templates and layouts in this idea book. This ensures that your titles seamlessly blend into your page design.

Layout Ideas & Design Tips

DESIGN & CREATE YOUR PAGE

With your photos, papers, and story ideas gathered, the next step is designing your page. The Designer Templates are a creative tool that can lead to many different expressions. In the pages ahead, our design team share a variety of ways this kit can come together—from clean and simple layouts to layered designs, thoughtful details, and even ways to combine the templates with favorites from your collection.

Each section highlights a slightly different creative approach. These aren't steps or skill levels—just different ways to explore the same templates, papers, and ideas.

As you look through the layouts, notice what catches your eye. You might try a similar arrangement, borrow a layering idea, or adapt a detail that fits your photos.

What inspires you to start your next page?

Let that be your starting point as you explore the pages ahead.

Create little accent pieces by repeating the smaller triangle shapes throughout your layout, then dress them up with penwork, sequins, brads, or enamel dots. It's a simple way to add texture, movement, and playful detail.

For a classic mountain look, use The Summit 7 without cutting out the center. Then layer the stencil pieces on top to create snowy peaks and give your mountains that timeless outdoor feel.



Use the circle cutout as a title card, then build a small title card cluster around it using simple phrases and die-cut circles. It creates a unique focal point that feels layered, playful, and easy to personalize.

Layout Ideas & Design Tips

ENHANCE WITH LAYERS

These pages build on the foundation of the Designer Templates by adding layers—using additional papers, patterns, and textures to create more depth and dimension.

Layering can be as simple as adding an extra paper or incorporating a few complementary elements from your stash—while still keeping your design clear and balanced.

An invitation to explore how layering can expand your page while keeping the process approachable and fun.

Instead of trimming your photo to fit perfectly inside the shape, let part of it peek out beyond the edge. This gives the photo a more natural, layered look while keeping the frame feeling playful and full of movement.

Use the Summit 3 tag template to add small notes like dates, places, or quick memory details. It's an easy way to tuck meaningful context into your layout without taking attention away from the photos.



Use specialty papers to add texture and movement to your layout. Crinkle paper can give the mountains a rugged look, while glitter paper on the tips creates a snowy effect. Metallic paper is another great option for simple accents—try crimping it for a sun, tag backing, or small detail to add extra dimension, fluid movement, and shine.

Layout Ideas & Design Tips IN THE DETAILS

Here is where the finishing touches come into focus.

Small additions—like die cuts, stitching, ribbon, stamping, or other play-friendly elements—can add texture, interest, and personality to your layout.

These details often become the final layer that brings your page together.

A moment to pause, look over your page, and enjoy the little touches that make it uniquely yours.

Use the center of the Explore stencil GPS cutout to add a title card detail. It's a simple way to turn that open space into a meaningful accent while keeping the design connected to your theme.



For a custom backdrop, print a landscape photo on vellum at about 50% opacity. This softens the image enough to build directly on top of it while still letting the beauty and awe of the landscape show through in the background.

For a textured look, add felt to the mountain tops for a soft snowy effect, or layer in vellum clouds for a more whimsical feel. These small material choices add dimension and help bring the outdoor scene to life.

Use a cutting file to create a custom title or themed accent that fits the story of your layout. It's a fun way to add personality, reinforce your theme, and make the page feel more specific to your memories.





Create a pull-out feature behind your main photo mat when you have extra photos or a bigger story to tell. A simple pocket can hold additional pictures and journaling, while an Avery tab, stamped detail, or small embellishment makes the interactive piece easy to find and pull out.



Create a small scene by clustering the Summit template mountains, trees, and clouds in a corner of the page or inside a collage box. It creates a scenic window that helps break up a photo collage while also adding a strong, eye-catching focal point.

Accessories: I Was Here (6), Wilderness (2), Open Air (1, 5, 8), Grizzly (2)

Kiwi Club Sets: Summit (2, 5, 6, 7)

Photos: Left: (3: 4 x 6, 1: 2 x 2, 1: 4 x 4), Right: (3 : 4 x 6, 1: 4 x 4, 1: 2 x 2)



Use the negative space in Blue Ridge Parkway (3A) to tuck in photos for an inverted mountain look.

Layer the Wilderness 2 mountain template with the Summit 7 template, then offset the pieces to create a shadowed look that adds extra depth.



Use the circle cutout in Summit 7 for a close-up photo, then echo that circle shape in another part of your layout for a more unified look.

Use the cutouts in The Summit 7 mountain template to frame small photos, patterned paper, or accent pieces. It creates a unique focal point that brings focus, movement, and a little extra fun to your layout.

Try layering The Summit 6 template and Whimsy Template to create a bright, dimensional sunshine-inspired design. Use the center area for layered paper, a title card, journaling, or even more photos.



Use the triangle shapes as title cards, photo spots, or playful accents throughout your layout. Add texture with metallic brads, stitching, inked edges, or specialty paper to give them a little extra personality.

Pair the Explore word stencil with title cards to create unique sayings, layered phrases, or custom page titles. It's an easy way to personalize your layout while giving your page a strong focal point.

The Summit template makes a great little home for your journaling. Tuck in a few words about the view, the memory, or the moment you want to remember.

Pair a few brads with the Summit arrow for a simple touch of texture and direction. It's an easy way to add interest without overcomplicating the page.

BEYOND THE KIT

As you settle into the creative rhythm, it becomes easier to create additional pages using papers from your stash—because you begin to recognize what works together.

The Designer Templates remain your design tool, ready to guide new pages with whatever papers and supplies you choose.

These ideas show how the same templates can continue to work beyond the kit—so your creativity doesn't stop when the paper kit is used.

Borders: Aspen Ct (2A, 2B)

Accessories: Triangles (2, 3), Whimsy (2)

Kiwi Club Sets: Summit (2, 5, 6, 7)

Photos: Left: (2 : 4 x 5) Right: (3 : 4 x 4)

To create a shaker accent for your page, build it by cutting a frame, a clear plastic window, and a backing shape with the same outline. Lay the frame face down, adhere the plastic, add foam tape around the window without leaving gaps, then sprinkle in your shaker filling. Peel off the foam tape backing, place the backing paper face down, press around the edges to seal, and finish with any extra embellishments you'd like.



Create more depth and variety with the Explore word stencil by cutting the words from one paper and the GPS pieces from another. This helps each part stand out while giving your title or accent a more layered, distinctive look.

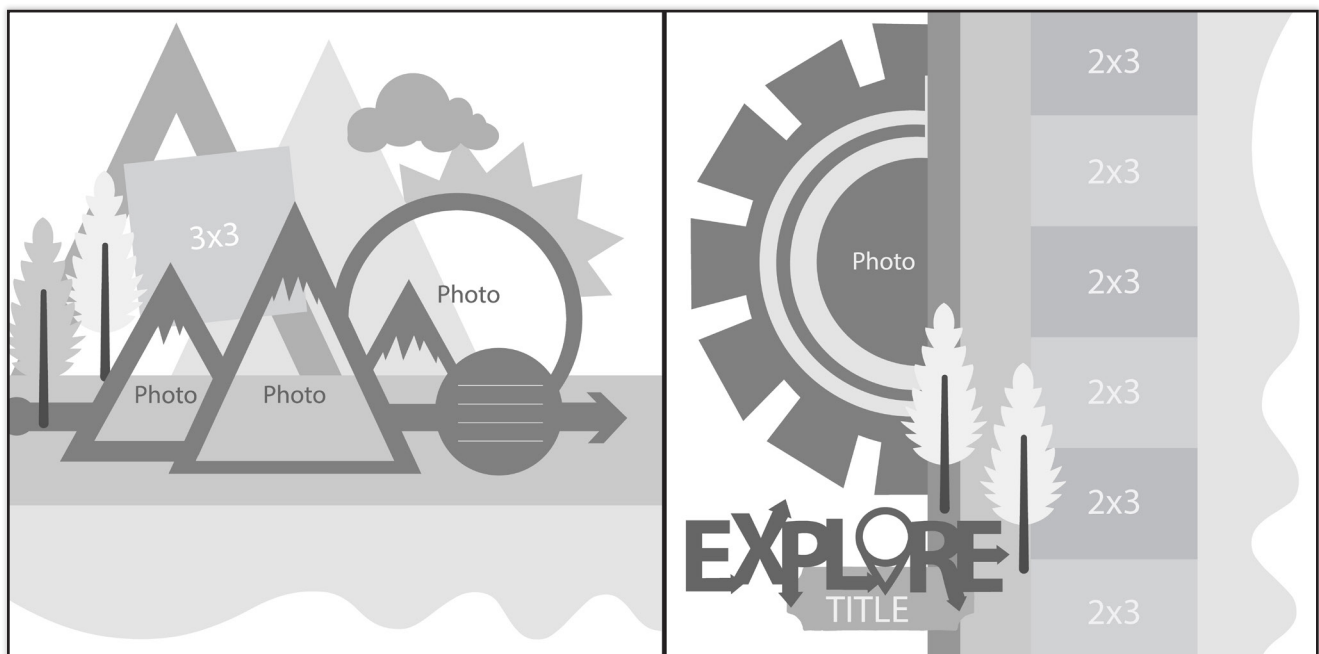
Use the circle cutout in The Summit 7 as a standout spot for journaling, a meaningful saying, or a curved title. It gives your layout a unique focal point while making that little detail feel intentional and special.



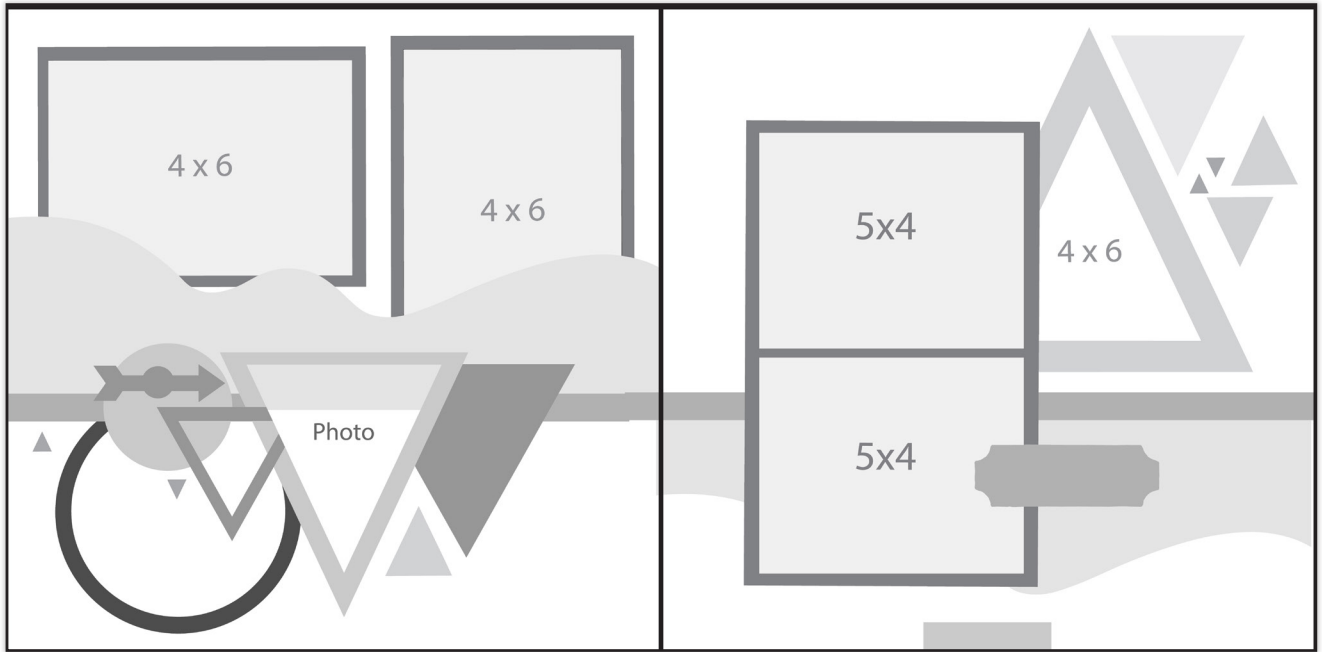
GUIDELINES FOR CREATING YOUR OWN PAGES:

- Start by selecting the sample that sparks your inspiration.
- Take into account the number of photos you wish to include and your paper preferences.
- Gather the templates mentioned in the layout spread's recipe.
- Arrange the templates to craft a layout tailored to the number of photos you intend to include. (Don't forget to use the photo templates for this step – they're a fantastic time-saving tool and help streamline your creative process.)
- Trace, cut, ink, and replace each layer with your chosen paper or the papers shown in the sample.
- Celebrate your finished page!

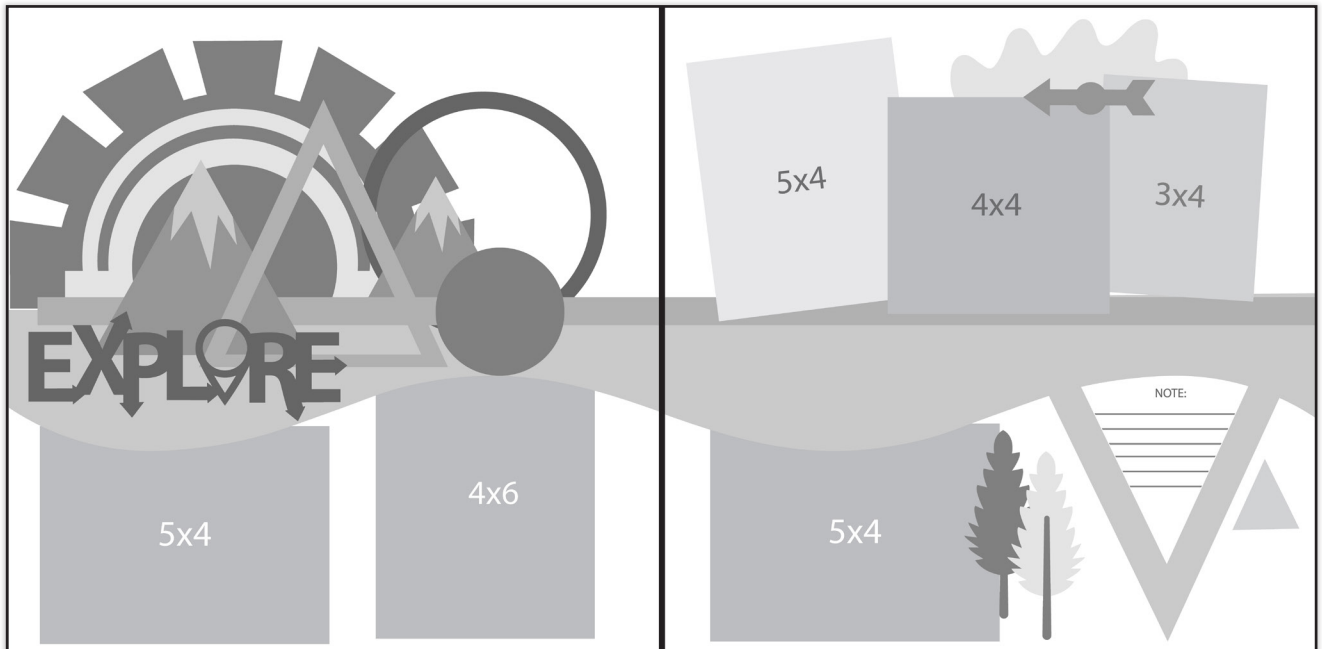
